

## Want to learn how to make your own Mobile App?

We will have live developer support from local senior developers from AT&T, Sencha, and Apigee to help students of all levels. Students can interact with professional mobile app developers and learn about careers in the mobile app industry.

The Hackathon is FREE to all High School Students. We ask that all students bring their own Laptop to work from. Smartphones will be available for on-site testing. Lunch is provided free!

### **Event Schedule:**

**10am – Registration and Set-up** – students to set-up their laptops and can play with a variety of smartphones.

- **10:30 am - Module 1: Intro to Mobile Apps.** Kickoff the event with an overview of types of mobile apps and tools used to make mobile apps.

Hands-on exercise with Web App tool. (No software coding experience required.)

- **11am - Module 2: Designing Mobile Apps.** A deeper dive into mobile application tools. Intro to Mobile Design Principles. Students will be given coding assignments (in small teams). (Some software coding experience recommended.)
- **12noon - Lunch.** Food will be provided for free to all registered students.
- **1 pm - Module 3: Careers in the Mobile Apps Industry.** Panel of professional speakers discuss “How to get a job making mobile apps.”. Students can continue working on coding assignments with their teams. Professional developers available to answer questions from students.
- **3pm - Conclusion.** Students turn-in assignments for a certificate of completion.
